 - Annual Time Commitment: A minimum of 16 hours per year, over (4) quarterly scheduled online meetings, during standard Alberta work hours.
 - Each Committee Meeting may have associated preparation work or content review to complete ahead of the session.
- **Diverse Representation**
 - We are seeking diverse perspectives, with representation across cultures, gender, and geography - and aim to reflect the diversity of the communities being served.
